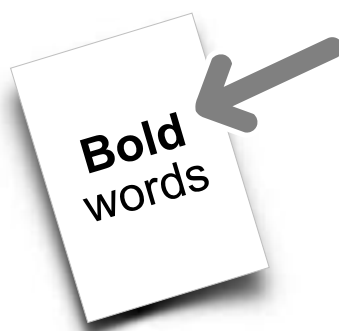

We are looking for a dancer to join our new project.



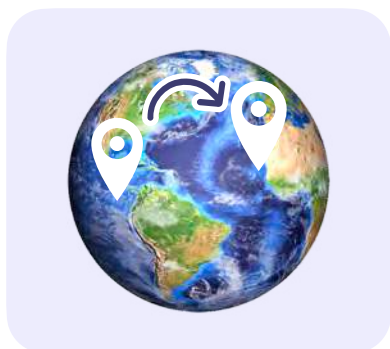
This information is about how you can apply to join the project as a dancer.

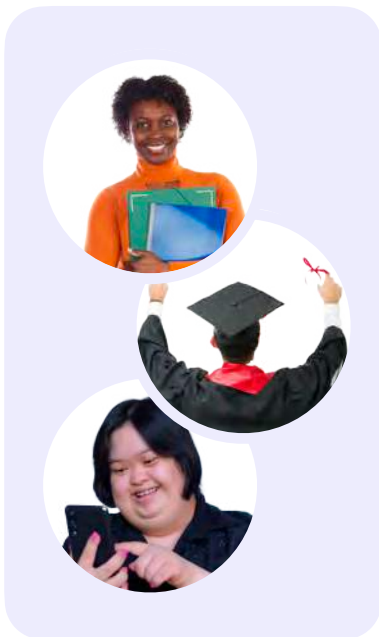


The information needs to be sent by Monday, 22 November 2021 at 5:00pm.

## 1. Your CV

A **CV** is a document that has information about:

- what jobs you've done.
- what education you have.
- how to get in touch with you.





## 2. A letter



The letter should explain why you want to take part.



You should also talk about why you are the right person for us.



If you don't want to write you can record yourself speaking instead.

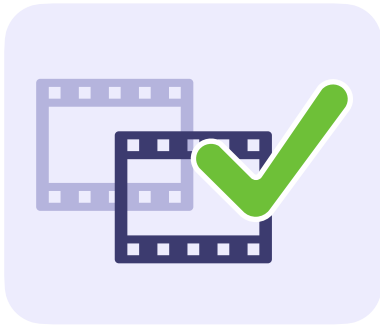
This can be a film or just a voice recording.

## 3. A headshot



A **headshot** is a photo of yourself that only includes your face and shoulders.
